



MAUI PREPARATORY ACADEMY PUEO PILOTS SCHOLARSHIP

For the 2012-2013 academic year, a group of donors, the *Pueo Pilots*, will be funding a four-year, full-tuition scholarship for a high school student new to Maui Preparatory Academy. Depending on funding, a second scholarship may be available. Pueo Pilot Scholarship applicants, who are not selected, are welcome to apply for a financial aid scholarship.

The Pueo Pilots Scholarship will be awarded to well-rounded student who demonstrate leadership potential in academics and a desire to make a positive impact in other areas of the school including fine and performing arts, community service, athletics and student government.

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for a scholarship:

1. Applicant must be entering 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade.
2. Applicant must be new to Maui Preparatory Academy. (Students who have previously attended Maui Prep or previously applied for the Pueo Pilot Scholarship, but are not currently enrolled will be considered.)
3. Applicant must apply and be accepted to Maui Preparatory Academy before Scholarship Committee considers his/her scholarship application. (Admissions application fee of \$100 will be waived for students also applying for the Pueo Pilots Scholarship.)
4. Applicant does not have to show financial need in order to qualify for scholarship. However, need-based financial aid is available for students who do not receive a scholarship, and applicants are encouraged to apply.

All applications for the **Pueo Pilots Scholarship**, with supporting documentation, must be submitted to Maui Preparatory Academy by **May 1, 2012**.

Notification of the outcome of the Scholarship Committee's deliberations will be sent to all applicants by the end of May 2012.

Please note that Pueo Scholarships will only cover annual tuition. There will be a few additional expenses that families will be expected to cover such as uniforms, books, school supplies, and Interim fees.

PUEO PILOTS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CHECK LIST

To apply for the Pueo Pilots Scholarship, the following must be completed and submitted to Maui Preparatory Academy by **May 1, 2012**:

- Completed admissions application**, including ERB testing and written essay, teacher references and official grade transcripts (**Please note**: Scholarship applicant must be accepted to Maui Prep before the Scholarship Committee will consider his/her application.)
- Scholarship application cover form** with all required documents
- Typed list of school and outside-of-school activities** (e.g. teams, clubs, musical or drama activities, community service, lessons, etc.) including roles played and levels achieved
- Two narratives/essays (preferably typed)**:
 - I) **Written by Parents** On a separate sheet, parents should provide additional clarification of the applicant's educational needs; how a Maui Prep education will benefit the student; and how they see their student's talents and gifts positively impacting our school 'ohana.
 - II) **Written by Student** On a separate sheet and in essay form, the student must explain why he/she wishes to attend Maui Prep; what his/her long term goals are; and how he/she will positively contribute to the school 'ohana particularly in the applicant's areas of interest.
- At least 1 letter of recommendation** from an adult who is not a family member (e.g. minister, youth leader, coach, employer, teacher, etc.) addressing applicant's leadership potential
- Optional**: Copies of commendation letters and/or awards certificates
- Personal interview** with the Scholarship Committee (required of all Scholarship finalists)

Applicants are strongly encouraged to complete all parts of the scholarship application at the same time that they are completing the school admissions process.
